T.O.L.	39/2158 Maitland 11 November 1839 (recommended July 1839), altered for Moreton Bay 17 th *** 1843 per letter from PM Maitland 42/13040 [or 42/15040?]. 4/4134 [reel 934]. TOL passport PP 41/0313, 20 July 1841, 4/4242 [reel 968]. Allowed to remain in the employ of Mr John Eales at Darling Downs for 12 months (Maitland Bench). TOL passport PP42/0702, 8 July 1842, 4/4246 [reel 970]. Allowed to proceed to Liverpool Plains in the service of Mr Jno Eales for 12 months. TOL passport PP 45/34, 3 January 1845, 4/4255 [reel 973]. Allowed to proceed to Liverpool Plains in the service of Mr John Eales for 12 months (Maitland Bench).
