1840 July	arrived in Sydney with a 10 year sentence for picking pockets
1841 May	admitted to Newcastle Gaol for 14 days in the cells
1841 July	released Newcastle Gaol and assigned to John Eales
1841 Sep	returned to government (at Newcastle Gaol/Female Factory)
1841 Oct	released from Newcastle Female Factory to marry John Walters
1841 Oct	married to John Walters at Newcastle (permission received 21 October 1841)

Other (source, details)

Newcastle Gaol Entrance Book, SRNSW 2/2008. Mary (sic) Roberts, *Surry* 1840, from Birmingham, nursemaid, admitted 29 May 1841 for 14 days in the cells. Released via assignment to John Eales on 9 July 1841.

Newcastle Gaol Entrance Book, SRNSW 2/2008. #888 admitted 15 September 1841 from Maitland, returned to government. Discharged to be married to John Walters 29 October 1841.
